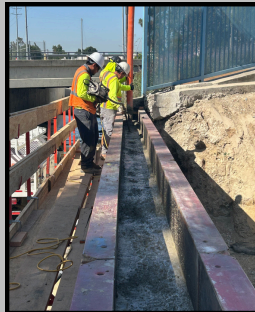

The San Antonio Creek Wall Repair project in San Bernardino County involves critical structural reconstruction to restore creek bank stability and prevent future erosion along this sensitive waterway. The scope includes demolition and removal of a compromised temporary wall and construction of a new engineered wall system with integrated stabilization components. This project also features installation of curb to redirect storm water flows and prevent another failure. Additional elements include removal and reinstallation of chainlink.

Our team executed the work under environmental and safety protocols, with an emphasis on rapid mobilization, quality assurance, and maintaining minimal disruption to the surrounding community, all in alignment with USACE LA standards and long-term flood mitigation goals. Despite seasonal delays, the project was **completed 30 days ahead of schedule, without change orders**, demonstrating the team's ability to adapt, mitigate risk, and deliver efficiently.
